SUMMER 2024 PROGRAMS

- For children born between September 2, 2018 and September 1, 2019
 - *Exceptions may apply
- Public schools, licensed private or faith based child care centers, licensed family child care homes
- 300 instructional hours



REGISTER FOR FREE VPK FALL 2024/2025 PROGRAMS

- For children born between September 2, 2019 and September 1, 2020
 - *Exceptions may apply
- Licensed private or faith based child care centers, licensed family child care homes
- 540 instructional hours
- Before and after care available for a fee

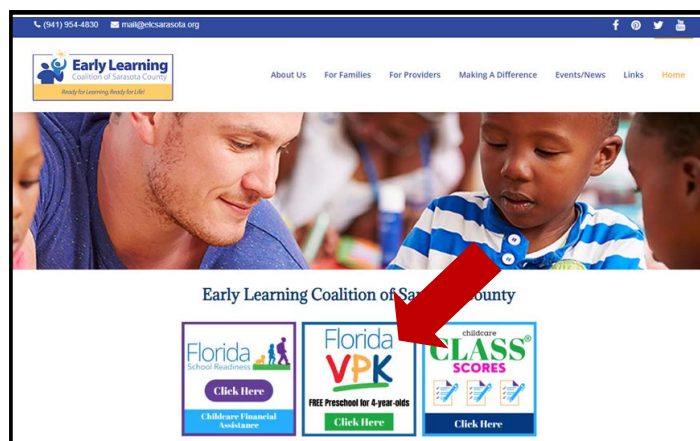
VPK is a FREE program to prepare every Florida four-year-old* for kindergarten and build a strong foundation for continued educational success. *Exceptions may apply.

You will need to upload two documents to complete your online application:

1. One Document for Proof of your Child's Age:

- Birth Certificate (original or certified copy **NOT** hospital issued birth certificate)
- Current immunization record from the Health Department
- Passport or other non-citizen documents issued by the United States
- Certificate of Baptism (original or certified copy) with notarized affidavit from parent.
- Religious record of birth with a notarized statement from parent OR Religious Exemption document
- Life insurance policy for the child (must have been in effect for at least 2 years)
- Valid military dependent identification card

2. One Document for Proof of Parent's Current Address (must show your COMPLETE address with city, state and zip code, and be in the parent's name with whom the child resides):

- Current utility, cable, Internet or phone bill (**most recent**)
- Florida Driver's License with current address
- Current pay stub (**most recent**)
- Vehicle registration
- Residential rental agreement **signed by tenant and landlord**
- Property tax assessment showing a homestead exemption

- Letter from homeless shelter or agency

Regular postal mail or post office addresses are **NOT** acceptable as documentation.
