

ELC's Storybook Street Hits It Out Of The Park: Reaching Capacity in 30 Minutes

On Saturday, February 8, 2025, Storybook Street reached a milestone like never before. Hosted by the Early Learning Coalition of Sarasota County (ELC) in the concourse of Ed Smith Stadium, the spring training home of the Baltimore Orioles, the beloved family event hit capacity in under 30 minutes, a first in its history.

More than 400 families with children ages birth to seven gathered for the free event, where over 8,000 books were distributed in just two hours. The 5th annual Storybook Street once again transformed into an "Imagination Destination," delivering literacy, art, and science in an unforgettable, interactive experience.

Families immersed themselves in whimsical story-inspired activities, live performances, music, and movement, with children dressed in costumes as their favorite storybook characters. More than 20 community partners helped bring books to life, from Gulf Coast Music Therapy's melodies to Nailed It DIY's arts immersion to hands-on learning with the Sidewalk Science Center.

The ELC also announced that Storybook Street 2026 will return to South County, continuing its mission to spark imagination and build lifelong readers. Details will be shared in the months ahead.
