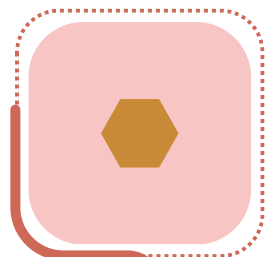

## ENTRY LEVEL COURSES



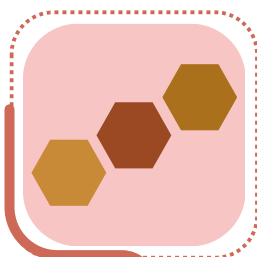

## PROFESSIONAL CREDENTIAL



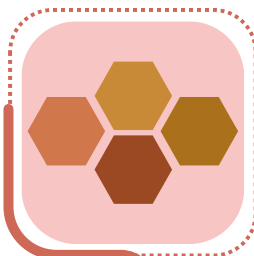
120-hour Florida Childcare Professional Credential (FCCPC). Offered through the ELC's free Apprenticeship Program
